

CIRCLE XX COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

The regular meeting of Circle XX CSD was called to order at 6:33 pm on April 18, 2026. Roll was taken, present were Directors Stubbins, Fudala, Bourassa, Davis and one absent Lopez, also present was secretary/treasurer Dean and Rich Fudala road manager. We had one guest Debby Hill.

Approval of minutes: A motion was made to accept the minutes of March 12, 2026, by Director Bourassa this was seconded by Director Davis, vote being 4 ayes Davis, Fudala, Bourassa, Stubbins and 1 absent Lopez.

Staff reports: We received the monthly bank statement, monthly county report, and a notice from the Registrar of Voters. The notice included a resolution calling for the General District Election and consolidating the district election with the county election in November. The paperwork also stated that three director seats will be open and provided instructions for candidates to register with the Elections Department. Candidate registration will be open from July 13th through August 7th. I will post these dates on the bulletin board at the beginning of July. On a motion by Director Davis and seconded by Director Bourassa, this resolution was duly passed and adopted by the following vote, 4 ayes Davis, Stubbins, Fudala, Bourassa with 1 absent Lopez.

No bills were presented.

Road manager: The directors have presented their assessments of the roads they had chosen and given them to Director Stubbins to compile the report. Each director was asked what their (3) priorities were. The board identified potholes and ditches as the top (2) priorities. The road manager distributed copies of the bid contract based on the directors' assessments and his own report, and the contract was revised with street name correction. He will contact interested contractors, send out bid materials, and schedule meetings to review the scope of work. Bids are due by May 11th.

Meeting adjourned: On a motion by Director Davis, seconded by Director Fudala, the meeting adjourned at 8:08 p.m. The motion passed with 4 ayes from Davis, Stubbins, Bourassa, and Fudala, and 1 absent, Lopez.
