

CIRCLE XX COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

The regular meeting of Circle XX CSD was called to order at 6:34 pm on August 20, 2026. Roll was taken, present was Directors Bourassa, Davis, Fudala, absent was Director Lopez with one vacant seat, also present was road manager Fudala and secretary/treasurer Dean. Guests present were Joan Wilson, Brian Rollinson, and Gina Gonzalez.

Approval of minutes: On a motion by Director Davis and seconded by Director Fudala the minutes of July 26, 2026, meeting was approved as presented. Vote being 3 ayes Bourassa, Fudala, Davis with one absent Director Lopez and one vacant seat.

Staff reports: Correspondence, we received monthly county report, monthly bank statement. I received a notice from the bank that our CD was up for renewal. The treasurer renewed the CD for 7 months at a Interest rate of 3.75%. We received the bill for our PO Box renewal, \$80 for one year. On a motion by Director Fudala and seconded by Director Bourassa this bill will be paid with check #2007 in the amount of \$80.00. Vote being 3 ayes Davis, Fudala, Bourassa, with one absent Director Lopez and one vacant seat.

Website: Rick Hill will continue updating the website with latest information about property cleanup following the loss of homes and outbuildings. The website received 8,207 page views.

Road Manager's Report: Rich is still assessing damage to district roads caused by heavy equipment damage, which must be pursued through the State of California.

Rich has also been researching the cost of replacing the entrance because the existing wood is deteriorated and the Board considers it a safety hazard. He received one bid totaling \$26,000 to replace the wood with metal posts set in concrete, rebuild the cattle guard, rent the necessary equipment, and remove and haul away the old materials. Because the Board considers this cost unaffordable, it proposes installing eight-foot metal posts on each side of the cattle guard, with a solar light atop each post. Director Davis also received a \$1,098.25 proposal to repair the cattle guard damaged by Cal Fire equipment, including replacing the bent pipe. Because the wooden entrance must also be replaced, Director Davis will ask whether payment can be made directly to the district and applied toward the total cost of the repairs and replacement.

New Business: Gina Gonzalez presented information about a concert she has organized for September 20, 2026, at the Town Square at Copper Valley. The event will run from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and will feature three bands. Food will be available from local restaurants. All ages are welcome, and attendees are encouraged to bring lawn chairs or blankets and enjoy an afternoon of music. All donations will go directly to the 18 families who lost their homes.
